




# DO I NEED STUDENT GUARDIANSHIP?

#### **IMMIGRATION SUPPORT**

Upon arrival in Ireland, non EEA students are required to report to immigration. We offer support with documentation and visa requirements

Taking care of international students studying in Ireland is our priority, from finding the right school in Ireland to finding the right homestay family. Students from the age of 8 to 18 staying in a homestay or boarding school without their parents avail of our service

# Before Arrival

#### CHOOSING THE RIGHT SCHOOL

Many important factors are considered by parents and students when choosing to study overseas including the country, type of school and fee requirements, the subject options available, exam type etc. We offer free consultation providing information to agencies and parents to help make informed decisions. Options include full time boarding schools, private day schools and public schools

#### CHOOSING THE RIGHT HOMESTAY FAMILY

Students that require a homestay will need assistance finding a suitable location and host family to suit their needs. We take into consideration the hobbies and character of each student. We take care in placing them with families that will suit their personality with children of the same age, where possible. Parents will have access to the homestay portal on our website to learn more about our fully vetted and experienced host families

### THE STUDENT JOURNEY

#### **AIRPORT ARRIVAL**

Students may arrive into Dublin or Shannon airport. We offer a warm smile to students upon arrival at the airport and the reassurance that they are in safe hands. Students will be met on arrival by an ISGI representative holding a sign showing our name and logo, making them easily recognisable. Students are then taken to the chosen transport option to begin their journey to the school or homestay

#### **ACADEMIC YEAR**

Students will always remember their wonderful experience in Ireland. We are there to make sure they look back on their time with fond memories. We provide a full time professional service throughout the academic year including

- Arrival and final departure airport transfers
- School books, uniforms and bed linen organised and available upon arrival
- 24 hour availability for emergencies
- · Close contact with parents
- 24 hour contact with host families
- On call for school concerns
- · Medical insurance organised if required
- Non academic support
- Regular check ups in person to monitor progress and well being
- Attendance at parent teacher meetings with follow up meetings if necessary
- School reports sent to parents
- Mid term and exeat holiday arrangements with host family/airport transfers
- Arrangement of additional transfers as required
- · Provision of Irish sim card



#### **BEFORE DEPARTURE**

Upon departure after the academic year, we arrange for students to arrive safely at the airport and check in for their flights. We complete all the necessary documentation and approval required by airlines for unaccompanied minors

#### HOMESTAYS

A homestay family is a very important part of the student experience and is one of the biggest decisions to make prior to arrival. A family you can trust to support your child and take care of the day to day needs is a priority. ISGI is there to help make this decision as easy as possible. All our quality homestays are vetted, personally inspected and deemed suitable for hosting international students following the relevant checks. Our host families receive annual training and orientation to ensure they provide the highest quality service available.

#### **Before Arrival**

We make choosing a homestay exciting rather than the daunting task it can be. We take into account the age and profile of each student and listen to all parent concerns. We take all details into consideration and compile a list of potential homestays in the area that would be suitable for your child

Confirmed clients are given access to our password protected website page that contains a list of our homestays including pictures of their home and family as well as a short description of the facilities offered and the bedroom type etc.

#### **Additional Nights**


Some students may require additional stays with their host families during the course of the academic year. ISGI coordinate any extra stays including mid term holidays and boarding house closures.

#### Meals

Nutritious meals are provided by the homestay on a daily basis. Students are provided with 3 meals a day, plus snacks. Any dietary requirements can be catered upon request. Any issues with meals should be reported directly to ISGI







## **SCHOOL PLACEMENT**

#### **SCHOOL TYPES**

Ireland has an excellent track record for providing the highest quality of education and consistently ranks as one of Europes top ranking education systems. Irish High Schools are known locally as "Secondary Schools" and consist of 3 main schooling cycles

- Junior Cycle 3 years
- Transition Year (TY) 1 year
- Senior Cycle 2 years

In the final year of the senior cycle, students take their final exam known as the "Leaving Cert". This exam is considered the equivalent of the A levels and enables students enter University undergraduate courses.

#### **PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

Government public schools are available to EU citizens only. Students can enrol for semester stays or full academic year programmes with transition year (TY) being the most popular choice. Full time host family placements are organised for students who wish to attend these schools.

# PRIVATE FEE PAYING SCHOOLS

There are three types of private schools

- Full time day schools
- Part time boarding
- Full time boarding

Fees vary depending on the chosen school with consultation available for parents to discuss options suited to their needs and preferences. Schools include Villiers IB school, Glenstal Abbey, Tutorial College, Rockwell College, Cistercian college and many across Ireland.

#### **IB SYLLABUS SCHOOLS**

Parents wishing their children to study the International Baccalaureate (IB) Syllabus have the chance to enrol their students in Villiers IB Boarding School which is one of Ireland's most established schools with over 200 years of history, situated in the heart Limerick.
